You will also learn a wide range of theory to underpin your choices.

You will receive personalised feedback on each of your assigned task drafts and the final version before submission to Trinity.

The online sessions are run in a cohort and you will also be assigned collaborative tasks between live sessions, giving you ample opportunity to collaborate with peers. Questions will be posted on the forum and you will be invited to exchange your experience, expertise and opinions so the learning continues. Our experienced trainers are present on the forum throughout the course to answer any questions you may have.
